Agenda Item #1: Emergency Readiness (Drills)

a. Discussion, b. Decisions, c. Next Steps:

a. In the 19-20 school year there will be a total of 12 Emergency Drills: 4 Lockdown Drills & 8 Evacuation Drills. 8 Emergency Drills must be completed by December 31st.

-To date 1 Lockdown Drill and 3 Evacuation Drills have been completed.

b. The school will comply with the mandates.

c. There are 4 more Emergency Drills that must be completed by Dec. 31st.

c. -Doors will be locked.

-Cleaners will lock the individual rooms after cleaning them.
