Assignment #1 Spider Trading Cards

Assignment #2 What if Literary Activity

You are going to Create a book blurb about a new novel with your spider as the main CharaCter. If one of your spiders were the main CharaCter of the story what will their name be? Create a book jaCket with a blurb about the book.

Assignment #3 (Book Review)

Please write a book review for the two books: *Moxy Maxwell Does Not Love Stuart Little* by Peggy Gifford. A book review is at least three to four paragraphs long. In your first paragraph, summarize what the book was about. In the next two-three paragraphs write all the reasons why you recommend or don't recommend the book to others. Make sure to use specific text evidence from the book to support your opinion. The attached rubric will guide you to do your best work.

Book Review Format:

Paragraph 1: Introduction and summary of the book

Paragraphs 2-3: In each body paragraph give one reason and at least 2-3 pieces of evidence from the book to support your opinion.

Paragraph 4: Conclusion
